**NOTICE OF RACE**

**1. RULES**

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing, the prescriptions of the Canadian Yacht Racing Association, the notice of race and by the sailing instructions.

**2. ADVERTISING**

Advertising will be restricted to Category C\*. Each yacht will be required to have a removable decal attached to the hull for the week.

**3. ELIGIBILITY and ENTRY**

3.1: The races are open to all boats in the following classes:

- kingfisher prams
- optimist dinghies
- laser/byte
- 420 dinghy

-mono hull yachts which have a current NSYA Data Sheet on record in the following classes: Spinnaker class

Cruising Class (if 3 or more boats are available each day)

**ALL COMPETITORS MUST BE A MEMBER OF A CYA AFFILIATED CLUB.**

3.2 Cruising yachts refers to yachts that are sailed by head sail and main or main only. Head sails are defined by Racing Rules of Sailing 50.4.

3.3 Eligible yachts can register on line at [www.brasdoryachtclub.ca](http://www.brasdoryachtclub.ca). Registration will also take place at the club during regatta week.

**4. FEES AND REGISTRATION**

4.1 Registration will be \$85.00 plus HST for the week. Daily registration will be \$20.00 plus HST

4.2 Registration will be available each day at the club.

4.3 Registration for the Gardiner Hubbard Bell trophy on Saturday will be \$40.00plus HST for those boats who have not registered in any other fleets.

\*Prams/Optis: Optis will share the same course with the prams. They will race for separate prizes. Race times for Thursday and Friday will be decided at skippers meeting. Gold and Silver Fleet for Optis will depend upon numbers.

A minimum of three races will be sailed. If time permits a fourth race will be added. If four races are sailed one drop race will be allowed.

\*\*Gold/Silver assignment will be based on results through Wednesday. One drop race. Fleet will sail together on Thursday and Friday. Positions scored each day will be assigned to competitors respective fleet assignments. If 3 races are sailed Thursday/Friday all will count. If 4 or more are raced one race will be dropped. A maximum of 7 races Thursday/Friday will be sailed.

\*\*\*ALL YACHT PRESENTATIONS WILL TAKE PLACE THE SAME DAY ON THE UPPER DECK

### **6. HANDICAPS**

Yachts racing must have a listed Atlantic Speed Potential Number PHRF handicap with the Nova Scotia Yachting Association (NSYA).

### **7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

Instructions will be available on line at the BYC website; [www.brasdoryachtclub.ca](http://www.brasdoryachtclub.ca).

### **8. COURSES**

8.1 Prams and optimists will race inside Kidston Island.

8.2 Laser, byte and 420 classes will start inside Kidston Island. All finishes will be in front of the club.

8.3 Open yachts will start outside Kidston Island. Cruising class will start inside Kidston Island in front of the club. The open yachts race will finish in front of the club.

## 9. PROTESTS

The procedure for protests and penalties will be provided in the race instructions.

## 10. SCORING

10.1 Prams and Dinghies: All races will count for prizes as per the schedule except in the event that 4 races are sailed for one prize. One drop race will be allowed. For gold and silver split on Thursday/Friday see above for scoring.

10.2 Yachts (flying spinnakers) will be allowed one drop race for the Marvin Harvey Award (best 5 out of 6 races). In the event of only 5 races 4 will count. In the event of only 4 races, all will count. The winner of the Marvin Harvey Award will be determined by the Cox Sprague scoring system. Cruising class racing qualify for the Marvin Harvey Award.

The results of each day's racing will be acknowledged at the evening awards presentations each day.

### 10.3 SILVER DART 100<sup>TH</sup> ANNIVERSARY TROPHY INTERCLUB COMPETITION

This trophy will be awarded to the club with the best score of all competing boats, representing their home clubs, for regatta week.

Each club competing will submit the names of the competitors to the race committee at the start of regatta week. They will choose from boats in the following manner:

1. Spinnaker class-----Two boats racing Monday through Saturday.
2. Prams.....One boat racing Monday through Friday

OR

Optis.....One boat racing Monday through Friday  
A different boat is permitted each day.

3. 420's.....one boat for each day. This will accommodate the boat rotation through the week.

Scoring: The scoring will be according to the race instructions. The club with the best aggregate score from all competing boats will be the winner.

10.4 The Gardiner Hubbard Bell race results will also count towards the BADDECK 100<sup>TH</sup> ANNIVERSARY TROPHY. This is in addition to the results from the McCurdy Cup weekend and Dundee regatta. Best 4 out of 5 races. The Cox Sprague scoring system will be used to determine a winner.

10.5 The Racing Rules of Sailing Low Point System, Appendix A4 will be in effect except for the above exceptions.

#### **11. BERTHS/MOORINGS**

Yachts will have free docking on the east side of the village wharf Sunday through Saturday. A limited number of moorings are available.

#### **12. RADIO COMMUNICATION**

A boat shall neither make or receive radio or cellphone transmissions while racing except, of course, in emergencies.

#### **13. PRIZES-see schedule.**

#### **14. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

#### **15. INSURANCE**

Each participating boat (yacht class) shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance with a minimum coverage of 1,000,000 per event.
